Rabies vaccine, Post-Operative pain shot and nail trim are included at no charge.

We do not apply additional fees for animals in heat, pregnant or with un-descended testicle(s). Please note these conditions when you make an appointment so that we can plan appropriately. We routinely perform pediatric spay/neuters at 2 months of age on animals weighing at least 2 pounds, but generally recommend surgery for puppies and kittens at approximately 3-4 months of age.

We provide all animals with a small tattoo adjacent to their incision unless requested otherwise.
